Minutes of the monthly **Full Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 19th October 2015** in Barnetby Village Hall at 7.15pm

1. **Apologies:** Cllr C Leggett, Ward Cllr C Sherwood
2. **Declarations** of interest (existence and nature) with regards to items on the Agenda. Cllr Wells pi on any item in connection with ERNLLCA & North Lincolnshire Council. Cllr Lawson pi item 11a.
3. **Public Participation:** Resident Janet Sykes asked if the Parish Council can help in requesting a Post Box in Victoria Road. She informed some residents are taking up to an hour to walk to the alternative Post Box. Cllr Wilson advised he has spoken to the Post Office numerous times and they are looking into the possibility. – **It was resolved** – Clerk to write to Postmaster @ Sheffield, cc Andrew Percy MP to request further large round Post Box at location on corner of St. Mary's Avenue near the grass triangle.
Thanks were expressed to Janet for her work on the War Memorial.

Lee Fielden from Barnetby United advised the toilets had been vandalised. He will repair the door handle himself. He has reported incident to Julie Reed (Clerk), but not to the Police. He passed the Acting Clerk a Business Rates bill from North Lincolnshire Council which has been addressed to him. **It was resolved** by Councillors present to pass onto Clerk Julie Reed to deal with direct with North Lincolnshire Council and reply as trustees to obtain rate relief.

Lee enquired if the Bowling overflow car park could be used by the football club if required. Chairperson advised this is not a Parish Council matter and should be raised at the meeting of the trustees of the Recreation Field.

4. **Approval of minutes of 21st September 2015:** The following corrections were made - Cllr Wilson advised item 2, should read Rita Agnew **Representative**. Cllr Bowness advised item 13, should read Mrs Aline **Reeves**. Cllr Lawson advised item 13, should read The Parish would also **expect** a page in the newsletter. With these corrections it was **resolved the minutes were a true and accurate record**. Minutes were signed by the Chairperson.
5. Chairpersons Report: Cllr Speyer advised due to Clerk's illness she was unable to attend this meeting.

7. **Ward Councillors Report:** Cllr Nigel Sherwood advised everybody has now signed up at Woodland View. It is at present waiting to be signed off by the Mortgage Companies. Cllr Lawson asked when the project will begin and an overall timescale, but no definite answer was given. Cllr Sherwood advised the condition of Skegger Beck was good, as advised by Rod Chapman, qualified Drainage Engineer. Cllr Monks expressed concerns regarding the area near the scaffolding is overgrown with leaves and feels this needs digging out. Cllr Wilson expressed flooding concerns as previously raised and asked Cllr Sherwood to go back to Rod regarding this and length of time this is taking.

Cllr Bowness asked if a bus service can be provided for residents to travel to Grimsby Hospital, as at present they can only go by train. Cllr Sherwood advised it is a good idea in principal; but as the route goes into North East Lincolnshire Council area it may not be their priority. He agreed to raise this item with Cabinet Member, Neil Poole.

Cllr Monks asked for update on Melton Ross Bridge and Cllr Sherwood advised this will be worked on during the Xmas period and should be complete for March 2016, but this temporary repair will only last 3-4 years.

Cllr Sherwood agreed to arrange an inspection of the roads in the village as Cllr Monks expressed concerns over the state of the crossroads which is littered with debris.
