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Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 16th September 2013** in St.Barnabas Church Hall at 7:15

Public Participation

Resident Janet Sykes thanked the Council for providing the plaque on the war memorial and requested permission to “Spruce up” the cenotaph in readiness for Remembrance Day. Chair approved the request and thanked Janet for the offer.

Resident Jo Johnson asked for clarification regarding the progress on the Recreational Field and what will happen to the BFG which was originally set up as a Parish Council working party. Chair advised the Clerk will respond in writing.

Skeggar Beck: Controlled tests have now been taken and the output should be available for the next Parish meeting.

Speed Monitoring: Will be carried out on West Street and Queens Road.

Footpaths: Survey has been 75% completed on footpath and roads and there were some minor issues which have been reported in and Ward Councillors will complete the remainder of the survey by the next meeting.

Cllr Carl Sherwood:

Travellers at Railway Inn: The enforcement officer advised no planning permission is required for less than 5 and the party were informed that a planning application would be needed. The travellers have now moved on.

Cllr Nigel Sherwood:

Footpath at Railway Street: Advised that the resident has not responded to correspondence or visit to discuss so NLC will now attend to the repair and this should be completed by the end of the month.

Road scheme: Advised that there are 3 options for improving safety at the junction of Mill Road and it will now be sent for public consultation.

Cllr Bowness advised that there is a parallel drain into Skeggar Beck which runs from the housing development at Church Hill and asked if it was possible that the foul sewerage had been connected there which would cause contamination of the beck. Cllr Waltham advised he would contact the drainage rep.
