**Cllr Rob Waltham:** Police have been informed about children playing on the railway. Leaf clearing in gutters and gullies is ongoing to prevent blockages. They have had a walk-about and noted overgrown hedge outside recycling centre needs calling in and various incidents of potholes noted and recorded. Network rail have now passed the ownership of the steps and wall at the railway embankment to NLC who will undertake future maintenance. The 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the Brigg Heritage Museum is now open, Brigg Lights switch on 29<sup>th</sup> November.

**Cllr Carl Sherwood:** Met with officers to look at flood alleviation on Kiegar Homes site and expect to start in Feb 2014 however this could be delayed due to problems with easement.

**Cllr Nigel Sherwood:** Walkers Close has had enforcement officers patrolling and found no real problems but will revisit in a couple of weeks time.

Proposals for Barnetby Top have been provided and are being looked at. Highways to look at the problem with chevrons and high embankment at Prospect bottom.

Suggestion of clearing the Churchyard was **approved** and clerk agreed to write to the Church and ask if this was something they would like.

- 14. School snicket, CCTV and Fencing:** residents advise this is a problem area particularly with dog fouling, **resolved** Clerk to report to Dog Control Team and ask about CCTV options. Fencing lay on floor to be reported to owner John Maw.

Winter salt spreading, snow clearing, handyman and container.** This item has been carried on agenda numerous times **Resolved:** NLC are responsible for snow clearing not the PC, salting causes a problem with insurance once started it must be continually done. Handyman to be placed back on the agenda once the Recreation Field development has been completed as there may be a need for one then. No need at present for storage container.
