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Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 16th December 2013** in St.Barnabas Church Hall at 7:15

Public Participation:

Resident Bryan Smith of Jasmine House, Ferneries Lane raised concerns and objections to the council re Planning Application PA2013/1541. Narrow road for extra traffic and parking with multiple occupancy which could require more parked cars, impact on business at the end of the road, visibility problems entering and exiting the road, private un-adopted road, applicant not offered and contribution to the upkeep and maintenance of the road.

Resident Wendy Broughton also spoke on the matter stating new plans result in a large area of run-off to absorb water will now be hard-standing which could cause flood issues. Only 1 car park space per building allocated which is likely to be insufficient. The existing problems with the pumping station and not in keeping with the look and feel of the surrounding area.
