Cllr Carl Sherwood: Nothing to report this month.

Cllr Nigel Sherwood: Speed limits have been reviewed across North Lincs and many will be reduced the ones particular to Barnetby are: A18 King's Road reduce to 50mph Melton Ross to airport road also reduce to 50mph, stretch of A18 Melton Ross that is currently 40mph will reduce to 30mph. A18 Wrawby to Brigg Road reduce to 40mph. These changes are being advertised 16/01/14 and will take effect from Feb 2014.

Extensive bridge repairs on the A18 will need road closure for 3 months and an investment of £850k work is expected to commence around April 2014. NLC confirm salt bin will be provided at Cheshire House.
