Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 21ST July 2014** in St Barnabas Church Hall at 7:30

- 6. Clerk's report-** Previously circulated report accepted; matters arising from it were Chris Spencer authorised to overhaul the website for a fee to be advised. Proposed Cllr Speyer, seconded by Cllr Wells motion Carried.

7. Ward Councillor's reports:

Cllr N Sherwood

Humberside airport roundabout funding is now secured. Planning application in consultation for a new 100 bed hotel. The A18 Bridge will be subject to an engineering solution with Network rail only allowing works on a Saturday and Sunday which will have an impact on the length of time needed to complete.

Cllr C Sherwood

Advised that £100,000 application for funding has now been received from the clerk and approved. Each pupil in North Lincs will receive an additional £167 funding per annum St Barnabas Y1 and Y2 will also benefit from the free school meals programme. Cllr Lawson

thanked Cllr Sherwood on behalf of the school. Cllr Sherwood advised that the Flood Forum meeting had gone ahead with thanks to Cllr Lawson MBE, Cllr Wilson and the Clerk.

Timetables have now been updated in the bus shelter. On the matter of electrification of the railway line from Cleethorpes to Doncaster there is now a cross party campaign with all the MP's lobbying for it to go ahead. Cllr Wilson again reminded NLC that there is still the matter of the pothole in Railway Street to resolve. Cllr Bowness asked ward council to look at the traffic lights just before the bridge on the A18 past the airport. Cllr Asquith advised that the wooden post to the left of the lane that tracks alongside the field has been removed and needs replacing. Also there should be a no cycling sign. Cllr Monks advised that the lorries are still parking at Barnetby top. Cllr Bowness advised that Church Hill drainage ports are not working and requested that NLC visit to clear the gulleys.

12. Village Notice boards

The clerk presented costing around £2,000 and the council agreed to have 1 at the Village Playing Fields, 1 at the Methodist Chapel and 1 on King's Road subject to permission being given by appropriate parties. The clerk advised she would bring a year to date and forecast of expenditure before any further monies are spent to the next meeting.

13. Remembrance Day

Cllr Wells requested monies to buy the wreaths on behalf of the ATC and the Air Cadets, St John's Ambulance, The British Legion and The Parish Council. Some Councillors were not aware that public monies were being spent on behalf of all of these societies and wreaths laid with no recognition of the Parish Council having purchased them. Councillors wish to continue supporting the event and resolved to donate monies from individual councillor's personal funds to cover the cost of a wreath from The Barnetby Parish Councillors. Council also resolved to advise the other groups that the Council can no longer expend public monies on behalf of other organisations.

- 3.) Stay as per previous years for this year and changes next year – Lost

15. Queens Road wall and safety Fencing

Bench seat at the top of Benny's Lane needs refurbishing. Item previously reported on CS 1975558 streetlight required on junction of West Street and St Barnabas is for an additional lamp not repair to a lamp.

CS2099416 Kings Road overgrown hedge still not resolved.
