**Public Participation:** M Rea and L Fielden updated the council on progress of the new pavilion and public toilets, they are expected to be complete by February weather dependant. They also wishes to thank the Clerk for her work on the funding bid and the Council for approving the clerk's time.

**7. Ward Councillor's reports:**

**Drainage Scheme:** Still in the hands of NLC Legal the easement deed with Deborah Scaffold has been signed but now all of the residents also have to a sign individually and not all have confirmed yet.

**Bridge Melton Ross:** To replace will be £5m, so the latest proposal is to prop it up which would cost £300k and allow access for HGVs. Talks with Network Rail in early stages.

**Airport Roundabout:** Work commencing Jan 2015, **Barnetby Top roundabout** work commences around June 2015.

The matter of removing the part built garage 63 Barnetby Rd is being dealt with by enforcement officers. Cllr Sherwood will look into the slurry sealing on West Street and the clearing of Footpath at Barnetby Top. King's Road LH side of the pavement collapse. Melton Ross Rd trees encroaching on the highway.

**Alleyway at School** – still continues to be a problem with dog fouling, conversation regarding CCTV resulted in Cllr Sherwood agreeing to look into it. Requests for a dog exclusion order were not

thought possible as the area has to be secured by a fenced gate to prevent dogs straying into the area again Cllr Sherwood agreed to look into.
