Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 19th January 2015** in St Barnabas Church Hall at 7:15

Public Participation:

Tony Lawson MBE Advised the setting up a group to arrange community events and will update the council as it progresses. David Wells advised he would help wherever possible. Barnetby Utd Football club also offered support.

1. Apologies for absence: Cllrs C Sherwood and clerk advised she has received a verbal resignation for Cllr P Britcliffe and has requested that he formally write to the clerk.

3. Ward Councillor's reports:

Drainage Scheme:

Cllr C Sherwood advised that Deborah Scaffold have signed, 3 residents have signed and 1 resident has not responded and another who is resident for 2 properties has refused the easement. When questioned on the legal status Cllr N Sherwood responded that North Lincs legal dept. are looking at the Drainage Act and Highways Act to see if any compulsory actions are applicable. NLC would prefer to deal with the matter directly with the residents to see if an agreement can be reached without resorting to legal.

Alleyway at School – Refusal of request for CCTV as it is not considered a proportionate response. Cllr Speyer suggested investigate DNA testing to identify the culprits. Clerk to look at PROW to see if it could be gated.

4. Participation to matters on the agenda. Residents of the Keigar Estate expressed their concern regarding potential flooding without the improved drainage scheme and cannot understand why residents are refusing to sign as it will reduce flood risk and insurance costs and increase the property value.
