Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 17th November 2014** in St Barnabas Church Hall at 7:15

In attendance: Clerk Mrs Julie Reed and Ward Cllrs N Sherwood, C Sherwood and R Waltham. 12 members of the public

Public Participation: R Hutching requested that the council provide a written account of what each individual councillor has been doing as there is an election next May and the Chair responded that it is the responsibility of individual councillors to promote their election and the Council operates as a team. He also requested the gate to be opened on the recreational field and was advised this is closed for safety reasons whilst building work is being undertaken. He asked if any consultation work had been done regarding the recreational field development and the chair explained in detail the consultation events that had taken place.

Andrew Tier advised that residents had seen surveyors on the Keigar site and asked if the council had any information on potential planning for the play area site. Residents voiced concerns about the drainage problems that could be further burdened by additional housing. Requested update in fibre optic broadband as it has been advertised as being available by 31st December 2014.

Resident advised that she had spoken to the church about planting 2 rowan trees in the churchyard close to the boundary wall – no objection made

Singleton Birch: have withdrawn the planning application in for moving many 1000's of tonnes of materials.

Precept: The same scheme is operating as last year with NLC giving grant aid at the previous level.

St Barnabas: The school will now receive an additional £28,420 following a campaign for fair share for rural schools led by A Percy MP.

Youth Activities: N L Council approved a grant request of £450 to continue the youth club.

Broadband: It is believed that we are in phase 3 which would be March 2015

Roundabout at Mortal Ash: Due completion on December 4th.
