Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2015** in Barnetby Village Hall at 7:15

**Present:** Cllrs: J Speyer (Chair), M Wilson, H Munn, M Monks, K Beacroft, V Bowness, D Wells, T. Lawson MBE and C Leggett.

**In attendance:** Clerk Mrs Julie Reed 4 members of the public and Ward Cllr Nigel Sherwood, Andy Brown Ludus Leisure.

**Public participation:**

Mr Bannon raised the issue of overlapping hedges into pavement obscuring access and egress close to the Fish and chip shop. Also raised concern about a barrier across the footpath in St Barnabas Road. He also raised that he could not locate the minutes it was explained that as the April meeting was cancelled and we were just now approving the May minutes so they would not appear on the website yet. Clerk also explained there were some minor issues with the website which were being corrected.

3. **Planning application design change PA2014/0952 Silver Street playing field development.** The Clerk advised that she had been in meetings with planning officers, environmental health and the supplier Ludus Leisure. Ward Cllr Waltham and Carl Sherwood also attended as did Cllr Wells. As a result of those meetings a redesign of the orientation of the skate park was proposed along with a look again at concrete modular ramps on tarmac pads. The Clerk advised that she had worked with all to achieve the best possible design option for success with the planning dept. to offer as much noise mitigation as is reasonably practical. Cllr Wilson proposed to accept the new design seconded Cllr Lawson MBE and **Resolved motion carried.**

Cllr Munn requested information on fencing that was raised as a concern, clerk has reported and will forward replies.

Cllr Bowness requested 2 signs for prospect corner “liable to flooding”

- 15. **Barnetby Community Fund request** – Due to the number of councillors included in this activity I granted a dispensation to any councillor wishing to take part in this matter. These should be declared as a personal interest, however any councillor having a financial interest should declare and leave the room. A grant request for 4 editions of a newsletter at £239 per issue and insurance at £235 was requested total grant £1191. **Resolved** to support group with 1 newsletter and the insurance costs £464 total grant approved
