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Minutes of the Monthly **Parish Meeting** of Barnetby-Le-Wold held on **Monday 20th July 2015** in Barnetby Village Hall at 7:15

2. **Apologies:** None
3. **Cemetery:** Cemetery Clerk not present yet defer to later in the agenda.
4. **Approval of previous meeting minutes** (already circulated) Full Parish Council Meeting Monday 15th June 2015 also minutes of the March 16th. **Resolved to accept** with the addition of item 8 The Woodland Scheme has stalled....NLC will inform residents involved of the current status on 15th June minutes. On March 16th minutes to be noted that Cllr Wells was in attendance.
5. **Public participation** with respect to items on the agenda None
6. **Chair's** report : The Chair attended 2 funerals this week John Pratt, a member of our community for many years and Linda Windass formerly from Barnetby, who died in the Tunisian Shooting. The Council observed 1 minute's silence.
7. **Clerk's** report – The clerk advised that she was on holiday for the next 2 weeks and that she had been working on general village matters, the audit and revised scheme for the rec field have now been filed with the appropriate authorities. The draft copy of an advert for the community service contract was discussed and **Resolved: to accept and advertise.**
8. **Ward Councillor's** report. **Cllr Carl Sherwood:** Drs Surgery agreed to the defibrillator and it will be fitted outside this week. Community wardens will start from 1st week in August, the civil enforcement officers, they now have the added powers to issue fixed penalty fines for anti-social behaviour, dog fouling, graffiti and litter as well as parking.
Cllr Rob Waltham: 2yr old funding now extended to 30hrs per week from Government and a review is being carried out to ensure sufficiency. The change in windfarm subsidies being withdrawn has been brought forward by Government. The water safety campaign is in this edition of the news direct. The Woodlands scheme will be going to court and will follow normal legal process.
The following Cllr raised queries
Cllr Beacroft: Can we have advice of who our community officer will be? **Yes, will advise clerk.**
West Street flooded last week Anglian water suggest another gully is needed. **Will refer to drainage team.**

Cllr Lawson: How many wardens? **9 plus 2 supervisors** all have powers and will be deployed
What has happened to letters to Riparian owners of Skeggar Beck **Will Chase with Billy Green to send out straight away.** Church Hill/West Street check the top towards Prospect Farm as its flooding **Yes**

Cllr Munn: Query on housing and what we can do to protect village residents from affordable homes being bought for the rental market. **NLS has just approved a policy that will create opportunity for builders to consider a wider range of properties, build to buy, build for disabled adults, build for older people, and build for starter homes. This will encourage a more diverse range of homes for planning to consider when looking at new developments.**

Queried the safety of spiked top fence encroaching on to highway and path on St Barnabas Rd. Clerk advised the matter had been passed to NLC who have advised no planning required. **Will check and report back but is it in private land?** Cllr Beacroft declared a PPI and left the room.

Cllr Wilson: Gulley at one stop needs cleaning. **Will be reported and cleaned**

Cllr Wells: Skeggar Beck, can Billy Green check outfall of subway and drain at South Street/West Street **Yes**
