- a) Highways and Neighbourhood Services Updates – Clerk shared a written response from Ian Jickells updating on previous actions re: Highways and traffic. The Mini Roundabout St Barnabas Rd/ Victoria Rd, a request has been made for re-painting.

The Footpath and Grass verges ban – IJ is happy to look into a trail for the village however he has requested that the Cllrs submit the particular areas of concern.

At 19:35 Chair Cllr Speyer closed the meeting to allow for a member of the public to speak.

W Brumpton expressed great concerns over a full ban of verge parking as this was cause residents of St Marys Avenue serious parking problems and should they park on the road then emergency services would struggle with accessing in emergency situations.

19:40 meeting was re-opened by Chair Cllr Speyer

After a lengthy discussion the Cllrs proposed that Clerk is to respond to I Jickells to request that Barnetby Le Wold wish to proceed with a trial for a full ban of parking on verges with the exclusion at this stage of St Mary's Avenue due to the unique problems of the narrow road.

A second motion was proposed and agreed that Clerk is to write to ONGO on behalf of the Parish to express concerns for the lack of parking spaces for the residents of St Marys Avenue.

ACTION

Futher discussion took place over the response in relation to the proposed sites for installing yellow lines, it was agreed that a full site visit with highways should take place to discuss verges and yellow lines.
