

## Barnetby under Fives

Barnetby under Fives operates from Barnetby Village Hall during term time, Monday to Thursday.

We offer places to children aged from 2 to 5 years.

We receive funding for 2, 3 and 4 year olds. We also offer the extended hours (30 hours).

The Thursday session is for rising fives. We support our children with a smooth transition to St Barnabas Primary School, taking them and staying with them on a Thursday afternoon during the summer term.

We received a Good grade from Ofsted at our inspection in June 2016.

We have achieved Step 3 with North Lincolnshire Council quality assurance programme, Steps to Quality.

In March 2018 we achieved Millie's Mark.

We are extremely happy with the 0 to 5 area. Our children use the large piece of equipment in different ways, including a pirate ship!

We also use the Muga.

We have no places available until the Autumn Term 2018.

We have 19 rising fives leaving at the end of the summer term.

We currently have 10 rising five children registered for autumn 2018. This is quite low, but this is quite normal, usually every 4 or more years.

We have many younger children on our waiting list waiting to take up a place in autumn 2018 and 2019.

We may offer more places for 2 year old due to high numbers of younger children.

We offer stay and play sessions to help children settle into our setting after their induction with their key person.

We are managed by a committee of volunteers; staff supervise the day to day management in the setting.

Our staff have years of experience and continue to train to deliver excellent teaching learning for ALL children.

I have worked at Barnetby under Fives for over 25 years. I began when my children started school as a "relief" member of staff, and for many years I have been the supervisor.

At the end of the summer term I am "retiring" as the supervisor and Sally, my deputy is taking on the role.

Family commitments are the main reason for “retiring”. I will miss the children, staff and committee.

However I am considering a “relief/casual position in early years!
