Resident of Low Farm raised the concerns of the Flooding at the Recreational Field.

In Playing field in 2010 repair was done in the field seemed to fix the problem, the amount of water is very deep. Where the drain is broken could possibly be a fracture in the field – man hole cover over towards the playing field.

Cllr Lawson MBE asked if this has been raised with NLC Flood Team. The Resident confirmed that it had.

Cllr Wilson - Pipe that runs along the playing field under the village hall into Skegger Beck.

Land drain – pipe could be blocked 10–14-inch pipe

Corner of the field built up with bricks and soil – was a gully into the field from the kissing gate. Pipe between Village Hall and resident field – run underneath the last house of silver street.

Nigel Nutting – concerned about the Flood and action that Keigars started with building works – lots of people getting worried and concerned.

Cllr Wilson – proposed that we ask the Ward Cllrs to call it into the Planning Committee for the following reasons:

Concerns about the possibility of the roof overlooking neighbouring gardens.

Concerns to the increase of vehicles and the impact this may have to parking on the highway.

The property is increasing from a 3 bed to a 5 / 6 bedded property. Considerations to be given to moving the garage back to give more parking space.

Amendment – that the impact of the overlooking should be assessed and if it causes concerns to neighbouring properties then a recommendation passed that Obscured glass in used.

3 in favour / 1 against - Amendment Passed.

Resolution – Clerk to submit a request to Ward Councillors to call into planning committee due to concerns over overlooking to neighbouring properties and parking spaces to be reviewed to limit the impact of vehicles parking on the Highway.


