The committee to support this decision and that the development would further add to Traffic, Noise, Road safety - both Drivers and Pedestrians. The dwellings do not appear to have sufficient space in front of the site for 4 cars which therefore would add to an already congested village for parked cars.

In respect of drainage and sewerage, the village is currently a known issue for insufficient drainage there are a further 23 dwellings proposed in close proximity to the site this will further add to the strain on the flow of water and sewerage which is already at high capacity.

If the proposal is considered and passed would the LLFA Enfielding Team consider a condition that the pipe for the sewer under the highway (Kings Road / Victoria Road) is re-laid to the width of an Elmwood with the sewerage be transported into Slegger Beck canal then the correct headwall back.
